Rev. Dr. Joe B. Maddox was born on a farm in Harris County, Georgia, as the youngest of nine children. He is married to the former Ms. Vernica L. Andrews. Dr. Maddox currently serves as Interim Pastor of Payne Avenue Missionary Baptist Church in Knoxville, Tennessee, while also holding the title of Pastor Emeritus of New Hope Missionary Baptist Church, where he faithfully served as Pastor-Teacher for 38 years.

In addition to his distinguished pastoral ministry, Dr. Maddox enjoyed a notable career in public service and environmental leadership. His professional roles included Deputy Field Office Director with the United States Department of the Interior's Office of Surface Mining, Chief of the Division of Tennessee Permitting, Chief of the Branch of Biological Sciences, and Revegetation Specialist with the Tennessee Valley Authority.

Dr. Maddox has provided visionary leadership throughout Baptist and community organizations. He is a former President, Director of Missions, and Chairman of the Board for the Tennessee Baptist Missionary and Educational Convention, Inc. He also served as Moderator of the Knoxville District Baptist Missionary & Educational Association, Director of American Baptist College in Knoxville, and President of the Oak Ridge, Tennessee Chapter of the NAACP.

A passionate advocate for missions and theological education, Dr. Maddox has planted churches in Africa, taught missionaries in the Virgin Islands since 1996, and trained pastors and lay leaders throughout Africa since 2007. He also helped establish Bible schools in Kenya and Uganda. Additionally, he is the founder and former president of the Knoxville Interdenominational Bible Institute, co-organizer and president of S.A.F.E. Ministries, Inc., and co-president of Justice Knox Ministries.

Throughout his life and ministry, Dr. Maddox has received numerous recognitions and awards, including being named among the Outstanding Young Men of America and Who's Who in the South and Southwest. He has also received proclamations from the Tennessee House of Representatives, the Justice Award from the Knoxville Chapter of the NAACP, and the Distinguished Service Award from the Martin Luther King, Jr. Commission.

Dr. Maddox is also an accomplished author. His memoir, *Won't He Do It! Trusting God in the Midst of. A Memoir of Relationships, Racism, and Redemption*, reflects his lifelong commitment to faith, justice, and service. He has additionally authored and co-authored numerous technical papers in both refereed and non-refereed journals.

ASTHMA

Asthma is a chronic (long-term) disease that causes inflammation and swelling of the airways. This results in narrowing of the large and small airways that carry air from the nose and mouth to the lungs.

TRIGGERS

Symptoms can appear when you are exposed to a trigger. A trigger is something that you are sensitive to that makes the airways inflamed. Common triggers are pollen, air pollution, animals, scents, weather changes, smoke, dust mites, and exercise.

SYMPTOMS

Coughing • Shortness of Breath • Wheezing • Chest Tightness
Asthma may lead to a medical emergency. It's important to know the signs of an asthma attack.

DIAGNOSIS

- Physical Exam
- Allergy Tests
- Lung Function Tests
- Blood Tests (look for certain markers)
- Chest or Sinus X-ray

TREATMENT

Treatment often involves medication and avoiding asthma triggers.

If you have asthma and/or allergies, it is recommended that you see an allergist or pulmonologist.

SYMPTOMS

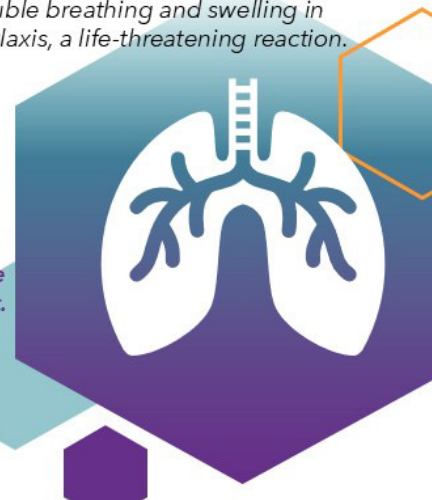
Watery Eyes • Runny Nose • Sneezing • Rash • Hives
More serious symptoms like trouble breathing and swelling in mouth or throat, may be anaphylaxis, a life-threatening reaction.

DIAGNOSIS

- Review of Medical History
- Physical Exam
- Allergy Tests

TREATMENT

Based on severity of symptoms.
