Begins in April



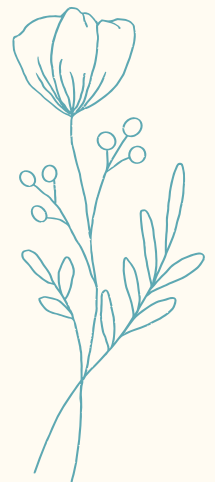
