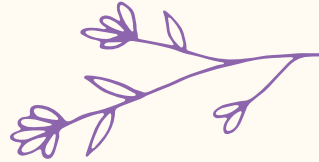

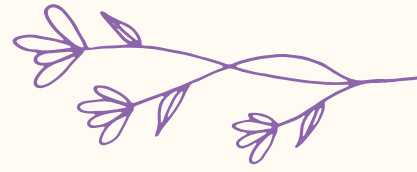
Friday: 6:15–9:15 PM Saturday: 8:30 AM–3:00 PM

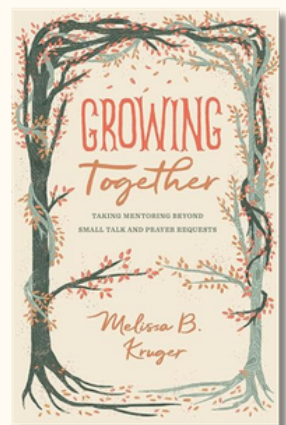
