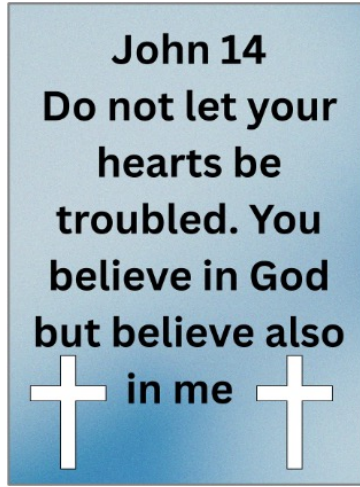
2026 CONFIRMATION CLASS AND THEIR VERSES

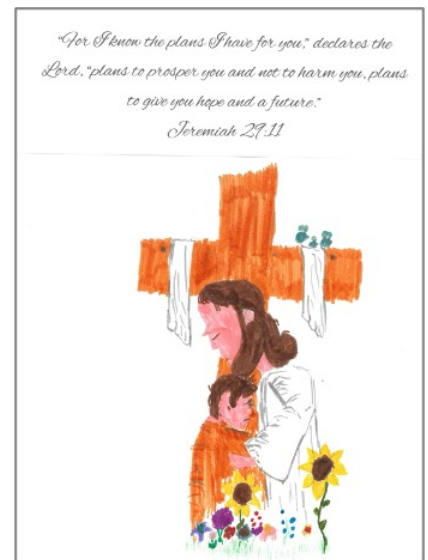
