Hosanna to the King

BIBLE STORY

Jesus' Entry into Jerusalem
(Matthew 21:1-11)

MATERIALS


Construction paper
Green yarn, cut in 24" lengths
Dull tapestry needle
Pencil
Marker or crayon

DIRECTIONS


1. Use a pencil to lightly draw a palm-leaf pattern on the paper.
2. Thread needle with length of yarn.
3. Sew over the penciled leaf pattern with yarn. Knot yarn on the back side of the paper.
4. Use a marker or crayon to write "Hosanna to the King" on the paper.

OTHER IDEAS

1. Sew several leaves on the paper.
2. Outline a whole palm tree to illustrate Psalm 1.
3. Write "Hosanna" by gluing or sewing yarn to the paper.
4. Use a marker or crayon to write "Hosanna" on the paper.



Lift High Your Palms: Fringed Paper



Bible Story

Jesus Enters Jerusalem (Matthew 21:1-11)

Make a palm branch. Wave it as you sing "Hosanna," pretending to be part of the crowd who welcomed Jesus, our Savior-King, to Jerusalem.

Materials

Two pieces of green construction paper

Tape



Scissors

Ruler

Glue

Directions

1. Roll one sheet of green construction paper lengthwise into a tube.
2. Tape the edges together.
3. Fold the other sheet in half lengthwise.
4. Cut 3" from one end. (Vary the length according to the size of the children's hands.) Unfold.
5. Fold the two sides toward the middle so they overlap slightly at the center. Crease each side and glue it down.
6. Draw two parallel lines, 1" apart, down the middle of the sheet.
7. Cut fringes $\frac{1}{2}$ " to 1" apart from the folded sides to the line.
8. Glue the paper tube down the center of the two sheets. Tape for stability.



Other Ideas

1. Fold one sheet of green construction paper in half lengthwise. Cut the curved sides of a palm on the unfolded side. Then cut a fringe into the unfolded side to a line 1" from the fold. Open. Glue a rolled tube down the center of the branch for stability.
2. Write "Hosanna" down the center of one side of the palm branch or along individual leaves.
3. Cut the palm branch from metallic green paper.



Hosanna to the King: Mobile


Bible Story

Children Praise Jesus in the Temple (Matthew 21:12-16)

The children cried "Hosanna" to Jesus in the temple. Make a mobile from colorful shapes to praise Jesus today.


Materials

Construction paper	Hole punch
Scissors	Yarn
Markers	Coat hanger
	Glue




Directions

1. Cut a strip of construction paper. Write "Hosanna" down the strip. Punch a hole at the top.
2. Cut the yarn into pieces of various lengths. Tie the "Hosanna" strip to the center of the hanger.
3. Make any combination of the following shapes to hang on the mobile. Punch a hole at the top of each one and tie it to the hanger with a piece of yarn.




Spring

- a. Cut a circle or square.
- b. Cut a continuous line to the center of the circle or square.



Fold, Twist, and Curl

- a. Cut strips of paper.
- b. Fold, curl, or twist paper into different shapes.
- c. Glue together as desired.



Slash

- a. Cut a paper shape.
- b. Cut several slashes into the shape.
- c. Bend or fold the paper pieces back. Glue in place.



Other Ideas

1. Hang various shapes from a wooden dowel.
2. Add glitter to the shapes.
3. Cut shapes from metallic paper, wrapping paper, or poster board.

Crayon Drawing

Bible Story

Jesus Enters Jerusalem (Matthew 21:1-11)

“Hosanna to the King,” the happy children shouted as Jesus rode into Jerusalem. Use joyous swirls of color to make a picture that reflects the happiness of that first Palm Sunday. Let it help you remember that Jesus, the King of Glory, will come again to take His people to the New Jerusalem in heaven.

Get Ready

Crayons
Construction paper

Get Set


1. Demonstrate how to make repetitive, overlapping swirls with the end or top of a crayon.
2. Set out crayons and paper.

Go

1. Draw a line across the length of a paper for the center of a palm branch.
2. Swirl lines of color on either side of the middle line to make the rest of the branch.
3. Add the words “The King of Glory Comes” to the picture.

Other Ideas

1. Tape several crayons together to use in drawing.
2. Tape the paper on a table. Hold a crayon in both hands and work on both sides of the branch at once.
3. Play music or sing as you make your palm branch.
4. Cut out your palm branch and add it to a classroom bulletin board.
5. Use glitter crayons to make your drawing.
6. Draw the palm branch to one side of a piece of paper. Write the words to “The King of Glory” or another Palm Sunday hymn on the other side.



MARK 11:1-11

This project helps children remember three highlights of Holy Week: the triumphal entry into Jerusalem, Jesus' crucifixion, and His resurrection.

MATERIALS

- wide craft sticks, one per child
- brown construction paper
- silk flower blossoms resembling lilies, approximately 1 to 1½" per bloom, two or three per child
- green palm leaves, approximately 11" long (or use green leaves from the silk lilies)
- Jesus stickers
- clay or play dough
- glue
- black marking pens
- heart stickers, optional
- white tag board, optional

PALM SUNDAY CROSS

HOSANNA IN THE HIGHEST!

DIRECTIONS

1. Cut brown construction paper into ¼" wide strips to make the cross, 5½" long for the upright section and 3¼" for the cross bar.
2. Glue the long brown strip onto the craft stick. Glue on the cross bar 1½" from the top. Place a Jesus sticker at the center of the cross.
3. Make a ball of clay or play dough, approximately 1½" diameter, and flatten the bottom to make a base. Insert the cross into the base.
4. Cut off the stems of the individual flower blooms. Insert two or three blooms into the clay base in front of the cross.
5. Insert the palm leaves into the base behind the cross to represent palm branch leaves waved during Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. If you do not have other leaves, use those cut from the silk lilies or make some from green construction paper.

SPECIAL HINTS AND OTHER IDEAS

1. Cut an equilateral triangle from white poster board, 4½" per side.
2. At the center of the triangle, write the name "Jesus" and attach a heart sticker to give the effect of "Jesus loves." Under that, write the child's name. Place the triangle at the foot of the cross for display.
