

21 DAYS OF PRAYER & FASTING

October 4 – October 24

Purpose: Growing Together in the Lord

As we begin these 21 days of prayer and fasting, our desire is to draw closer to Jesus and closer to one another. Together, we will seek the Lord through prayer, His Word, and intentional fellowship, allowing Him to deepen our communion with Christ and strengthen the unity of His church. Throughout this journey, we will focus our hearts and minds on the goodness and faithfulness of God, remembering His promises, celebrating His provision, and trusting Him for all that lies ahead. May these daily prayer prompts encourage us to grow together in faith, love, and gratitude as we become more like Christ and more committed to His mission.

Day 1 – United in Christ

Scripture: Psalm 133:1

"Behold, how good and pleasant it is when brothers dwell in unity!"

Prayer: Lord, unite our church in love and purpose. Help us grow together as one family for Your glory.

Day 2 – Thankful Hearts

Scripture: Psalm 100:4

"Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise."

Prayer: Father, fill our hearts with gratitude. May thanksgiving become the foundation of our worship each day.

Day 3 – God's Faithfulness

Scripture: Lamentations 3:22–23

"Great is Your faithfulness."

Prayer: Lord, remind us of Your faithfulness in every season. Help us trust You completely.

Day 4 – Loving One Another

Scripture: John 13:35

"By this everyone will know that you are My disciples, if you love one another."

Prayer: Jesus, teach us to love one another as You have loved us. Let our church reflect Your heart.

Day 5 – Walking Together

Scripture: Ecclesiastes 4:9

"Two are better than one."

Prayer: Lord, help us encourage and strengthen one another as we walk together in faith.

Day 6 – Devoted to Fellowship

Scripture: Acts 2:42

"They devoted themselves... to fellowship..."

Prayer: Father, deepen our relationships with You and with one another. Make our church a place of genuine community.

Day 7 – Resting in God's Goodness

Scripture: Psalm 34:8

"Taste and see that the Lord is good."

Prayer: Lord, help us rest in Your goodness. Open our eyes to Your blessings every day.

Day 8 – One Mind

Scripture: Philippians 2:2

"Be of the same mind, having the same love."

Prayer: God, give us one heart and one mind as we pursue Your mission together.

Day 9 – Encouraging One Another

Scripture: Hebrews 10:24–25

Prayer: Father, help us encourage one another daily and faithfully gather together to grow in Christ.

Day 10 – Abiding in Christ

Scripture: John 15:5

Prayer: Jesus, help us remain close to You. Apart from You we can do nothing.

Day 11 – The Peace of Christ

Scripture: Colossians 3:15

Prayer: Lord, let Your peace rule in our hearts and in our church as we live with thankful hearts.

Day 12 – Bearing One Another's Burdens

Scripture: Galatians 6:2

Prayer: Father, help us care for one another with compassion, carrying each other's burdens in love.

Day 13 – Seeking First the Kingdom

Scripture: Matthew 6:33

Prayer: Lord, keep our focus on You. May Your Kingdom always come before our own plans.

Day 14 – Walking in Humility

Scripture: Philippians 2:3

Prayer: Jesus, give us humble hearts that put others before ourselves and honor You above all.

Day 15 – Rejoicing Together

Scripture: Romans 12:15

Prayer: Father, help us celebrate victories together and comfort one another through every trial.

Day 16 – Filled with Hope

Scripture: Romans 15:13

Prayer: God, fill us with hope, joy, and peace as we trust in You.

Day 17 – Growing Spiritually

Scripture: Colossians 2:6–7

Prayer: Lord, root us deeply in Christ so we continue growing strong in our faith together.

Day 18 – Serving One Another

Scripture: 1 Peter 4:10

Prayer: Father, help us use our gifts to serve one another faithfully and bring glory to Your name.

Day 19 – Fixing Our Eyes on Jesus

Scripture: Hebrews 12:2

Prayer: Jesus, keep our hearts fixed on You and help us run faithfully the race You have set before us.

Day 20 – Overflowing with Praise

Scripture: Psalm 150:6

Prayer: Lord, let our lives overflow with worship as we remember all You have done.

Day 21 – To God Be the Glory

Scripture: Ephesians 3:20–21

Prayer: Father, thank You for Your goodness and faithfulness. As we finish this season of prayer and fasting, continue to grow us together in Christ so that You alone receive all the glory. Amen.
