FOUR ASPECTS OF A COMMUNITY GROUP

- ① **Community & Care**
Form meaningful friendships where you are genuinely known, cared for, and encouraged spiritually, emotionally, and physically.
- ② **Spiritual Health & Growth**
Grow in spiritual maturity through cultivating habits such as Scripture meditation & application, prayer, fellowship, and obedience.
- ③ **Discipleship & Ownership**
Learn how to be a disciple-maker where you live, learn, work, and play and take personal ownership in helping people know and follow Jesus.
- ④ **Mission & Outreach**
Serve the Big “K” Kingdom together through hospitality, service, and prayer.

The group covenant is important for establishing a healthy group dynamic. These are the expectations for every group member so that the group can thrive in knowing and following Jesus together. Please take time to review the following list with your group. Our expectation is that everyone will abide by these guidelines as long as they remain a member of the group.

As a member of my community group, I am committed to...

- ① **Participation** | I will make community group attendance a priority (and contact the leader/host when I will be absent or late). Everyone is encouraged to participate and no one dominates the conversation.
- ② **Safety** | I will help create a safe place where people can be heard without judgment.
- ③ **Confidentiality** | I will not repeat anything that someone shares of a personal nature outside of the meeting to someone who is not part of the group. What is said in the community group stays there.
- ④ **Respect** | I will not intentionally embarrass or dishonor someone inside or outside the group meeting.
- ⑤ **Care and Support** | I will choose to be fully present and provide care for the people in my group as needed – especially in times of crisis.
- ⑥ **Authenticity** | I will be open and transparent within the group to the extent I am comfortable with/is appropriate as our group grows in trust and friendship with one another.
- ⑦ **Conflict Resolution** | I will seek to reconcile differences, hurts, and offenses with my group members quickly, directly, prayerfully, and lovingly.
- ⑧ **Growth** | I will invite new people to our group when opportunities arise so that more people have the chance to experience Christian fellowship and grow in their faith.
