STEP BY STEP GUIDE FOR SCANNING

1. Log in to your E-Wallet or Bank App
2. Tap the QR icon on the main dashboard
3. Point your phone's camera to scan the QR code
4. Enter the exact amount you want to give
5. Review the details and confirm with your biometrics or OTP*

***REMINDER:** The Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (BSP) mandates that all banks, e-wallets, and digital finance apps must phase out SMS and email OTPs for high-risk transactions and account modifications by June 30, 2026. Instead, authentication methods will shift to In-App OTPs/push confirmations or biometrics.
