


Small Discipleship Groups Sermon Guide Questions 4 SEPTEMBER 2022



Conversation starters to begin:

Consider your general sense or level of gratitude, recalling the past days, weeks, and months. Share what you identified.

What is your most or least favorite work to do?

Before you proceed:

Read aloud **Ephesians 2:1-10**. Pray and ask God to enlighten you to show you where he has been at work and present in your past week through events, places, and people. Ask God to enliven and guide your group now in your reading and discussion.

- 1. What does Paul mean when he says we have been "made alive," "raised," and "seated" with Christ (vv 5-6)?
- 2. What has God's grace meant to you in your life lately?
- 3. What is the relationship between God's grace and good works?
- 4. How does understanding that you are God's workmanship alter how you view or perceive God?
- 5. How does it alter how you perceive yourself and your "neighbor"?
- 6. What good work do you sense or anticipate God may have for you to do now or before long?
- 7. Thank God specifically for some of the many ways he has been gracious to you. Ask him to remove any barriers to the good works he has created for you to do. Pray in the other ways you are led.
