Conversation starter to begin:

Do you know the meaning of your name(s), and if so, what is it?

Next:

Read **Matthew 6:9** aloud more than once. Before you begin, pray and ask God to illuminate you, to show you where he has been at work and present in the previous days, and through others; ask Him to illuminate the Scripture to you. Pause in your prayer, listen, and pursue His leading.

Kingdom Worship: “Kingdom Prayer” (Part 2)

1. What communicates respect to you?
2. Why do you think that we most often associate prayer with asking rather than reverence and adoration?
3. It’s been said that prayer is primarily about a relationship with God, that it is relational, not transactional. How does revisiting this notion of prayer inform or challenge your prayer life right now?
4. “Prayer trains us in conversation with the God who seeks us out – the God who speaks and we must answer.” Discuss this quotation from Eugene Peterson.
5. “In commanding us to glorify him, God is inviting us to enjoy him.” Discuss this quotation from CS Lewis.
6. When are the times that prayer is enjoyable? Describe a time or season when prayer was most enjoyable - what do you remember was happening in your life?
7. Be encouraged to speak out prayers of reverence and adoration. Reflect and thank God for one or two things in your life. Reference or read aloud Psalm 8 as inspiration.
