

Small Discipleship Groups Sermon Guide Questions 18 DECEMBER 2022



Conversation starter to begin:

What's a favorite Christmas movie of yours?

Share something encouraging to you of late - it could be anything.

Next:

Read **Matthew 6:11-13** aloud more than once. Before you begin, ask God to illuminate you, to show you where he has been at work and present in the previous days, and through others; ask Him to illuminate the Scripture to you. Pause in your prayer, listen, and pursue His leading.

Kingdom Worship: "Kingdom Prayer" (Part 5) 18 DECEMBER 2022

- 1. What stands out to you in the text? What impressions, curiosities, and questions arise as you ponder it now?
- 2. Read this quote by C.S. Lewis and discuss how it applies to your life and habits of late: "Relying on God has to begin all over again every day as if nothing had yet been done."
- 3. Has there ever been a time when you felt your financial needs were not being met? How did you see God provide for you?
- 4. Do you believe that all your sin (past, present, future) has been paid for in Christ? How can you be assured of it?
- 5. Has it ever been difficult for you to forgive someone? How did God help you in that situation?
- 6. When have you seen God deliver you from temptation or evil? How can we keep our focus on Christ as we experience trials and difficulties?
- 7. Spend some time in prayer as it flows from your discussion. How might God be inviting you or your group to respond and make a specific application this Holiday season?
