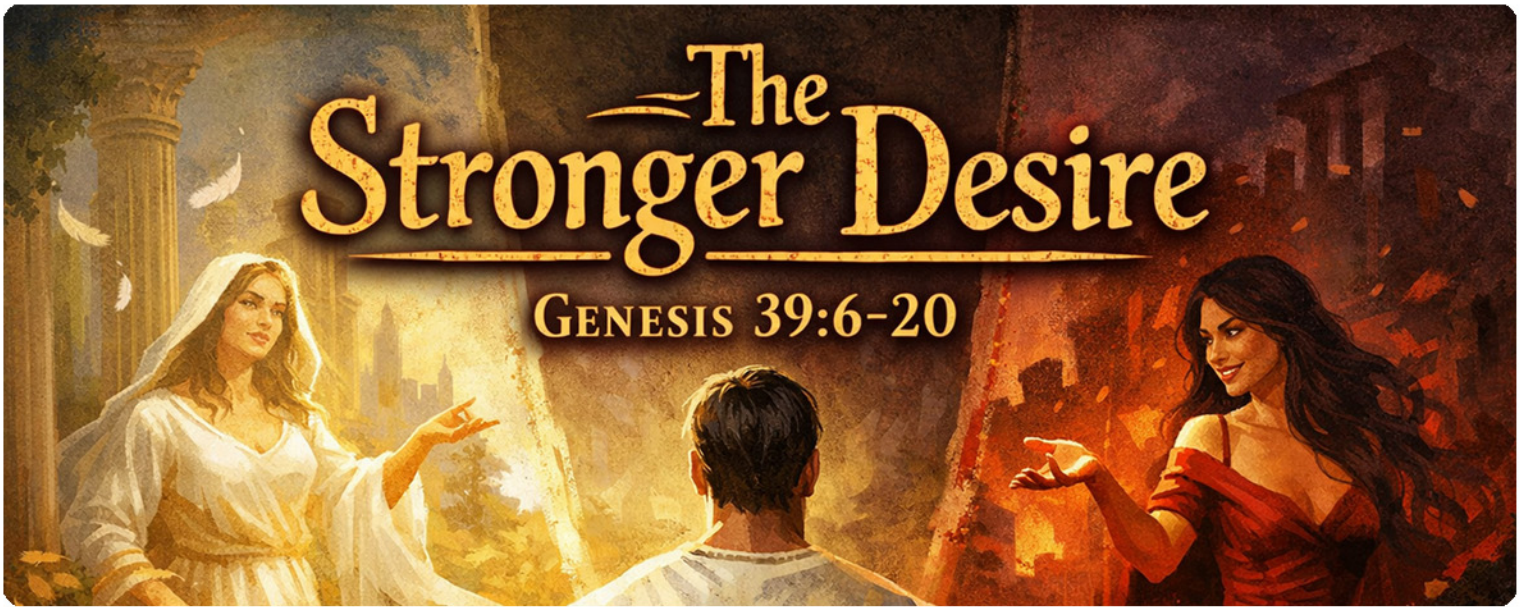

Questions for Further Discussion: Read Genesis 39:6-20

- 1) **Read Proverbs 9:1–6, 13–18.** What differences do you see between the invitation of Wisdom and the invitation of Folly? What makes Folly’s invitation attractive despite its outcome?
- 2) **Read Genesis 3:1–6.** How do you see the same “two voices” at work in the garden? What lies about God does the serpent introduce?
- 3) **Read Genesis 39:1–7.** What blessings had Joseph received at this point? How did those blessings create new opportunities for temptation?
- 4) **Read Matthew 19:23–24 and 1 Timothy 6:9–10.** Why does Jesus say wealth can be spiritually dangerous? What temptations tend to come with success, influence, or comfort?

5) **Read Genesis 39:7–12.** What made Joseph’s temptation particularly strong (consider pressure, persistence, secrecy)? Talk about why these are so difficult when we encounter them.

6) **Read Genesis 39:8–9.** What reasons does Joseph give for refusing Potiphar’s wife? What does this reveal about his view of God?

7) **Read 1 Corinthians 6:18 and 2 Timothy 2:22.** What does it practically look like to “flee” temptation rather than manage it?

8) **Read Matthew 22:37–38 and Psalm 73:25–26.** What does it mean to truly desire God above all else? How does a deep love for God help us in our temptations?

9) **Read Genesis 29:20 and Galatians 5:16–17.** How did Pastor Chad connect the story of Jacob’s love for Rachel to temptation? Why does Jacob remain loyal to Rachel when he may have been tempted to move on?

10) **Read Philippians 2:14–15 and 1 Corinthians 10:9–10.** Why is grumbling taken so seriously in Scripture? When are you most tempted to question God’s goodness?

11) **Read Habakkuk 3:17–19 and Romans 8:28.** How does Habakkuk respond when everything is going wrong? What truths about God can help you resist the temptation to doubt or complain?
