- Recruit, develop, and encourage worship ministry volunteers.
- Build meaningful relationships with team members.

- Support the elders by investing in volunteers and helping cultivate the spiritual health of the Amplify Team.

Shape Worship Gatherings

- Collaborate with the Lead Pastor in planning Christ-centered worship gatherings.
- Select songs that faithfully communicate biblical truth and support the weekly teaching.
- Lead congregational worship with authenticity, confidence, and humility.
- Help create gatherings that invite participation rather than performance.

Build Healthy Systems

- Schedule volunteers through Planning Center.
- Host weekly rehearsals that are organized, encouraging, and spiritually meaningful.
- Coordinate with production volunteers regarding audio, visual, and stage needs.
- Maintain worship ministry equipment and oversee inventory.
- Develop sustainable systems that support a growing volunteer-based ministry.

- Model a growing relationship with Jesus.
- Live with humility, teachability, and integrity.
- Communicate clearly and graciously.
- Protect the unity of the church.
- Support the mission, doctrine, leadership, and culture of Second Mile Church.

- Humility, teachability, emotional maturity, and a servant-hearted approach to leadership.

Leadership

- Proven leadership experience with strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Experience leading and managing volunteer-based teams.
- Ability to recruit, encourage, equip, and develop volunteers.
- Strong organizational and planning abilities.

Worship Leadership

- Minimum of 1-3 years of worship leading experience
- Strong vocal ability and confidence leading a congregation.
- Ability to organize and lead weekly rehearsals.
- A heart to lead people in worship rather than perform for them.

Technical & Administrative

- Minimum requirement High School degree or equivalent.
- Knowledge of Planning Center or ability to learn and implement church management software within the first 60 days.
- General understanding of audio, visual, and stage systems.
- Ability to coordinate worship ministry logistics with consistency and excellence.

Ideal Qualifications

- Proficiency on guitar, piano, or another primary worship instrument.
- Broad understanding of vocal harmonies and arranging.
- Experience maintaining worship equipment and managing inventory.
- Experience developing future worship leaders through coaching and apprenticeship.
