




God loves the sinner but not the sin. God never intended to throw His people away because of their sin. God has an amazing way of helping people see what is destroying them and showing them how to do better. What to do better we need God's help. The first step is seeing what's wrong, then you can change with God's help. Daniel shows us how by confessing the sins of his people and asking for mercy.

Never has there been such a disaster as happened in Jerusalem. Daniel 9:11-12 NLT

13Every curse written against us in the Law of Moses has come true. Yet we have refused to seek mercy from the LORD our God by turning from our sins and recognizing his truth. 14Therefore, the LORD has brought upon us the disaster he prepared.
