Black History Moment:

Some folks called me a traitor, Lol because I rooted for Dusty!! I stand accused 😊 - Congratulations to Dusty Baker!! The third black manager to win a World Series. He also won his 2,000th game during the series becoming the 12th manager in major league history to reach the milestone and the first black man to do it. He is also the only manager in major league history to take five different teams to the postseason. All we ask for is a chance!! As of today, they are 42 days left in 2022. We look back at some events that happen in 2022. Politics, despite historic campaigns, no Black women won Senate or governor races in 2022 midterms. Not all were vying for a seat in Congress. Some were going for state office, including the governor, attorney general, secretary of state, and more. Either way, they are diversifying the country's political landscape, often dominated by white men. These Black candidates made history during The 2022 Midterm Elections. There have only been two Black elected governors in US history. This is the third, Governor Wes Moore was elected Maryland's first Black governor. Anthony Brown was elected the state of Maryland first black Attorney General. Summer Lee becomes the first Black woman elected to Congress from Pennsylvania. She cracked the glass ceiling in Pennsylvania after winning her U.S. House race in the state's 12th Congressional District. Emilia Sykes becomes the third Black woman to represent Ohio's House delegation. Her win in Ohio's 13th Congressional District now means that three Black women will be serving in the state's U.S. House delegation (along with U.S. Reps. Joyce Beatty and Shontel Brown). Andrea Campbell was elected as the state of Massachusetts' first Black female attorney general and the first Black woman ever. These leaders will shake up the status quo and we congratulate them. This is an excerpt from Nikki Giovanni's Latest Poem: 'Vote,' "I am a citizen, I must be able to vote. Folks were lynched. Folks were shot. Folks communities were gerrymander, Folks who believed in the Constitution were lied to, Burned out, bought and sold because. They agreed that all men and women were created equal. Folks vote to make us free, It's not cookies or cake. But it is icing that is so sweet, Good for us, my country tis of thee."
