Pumpkin Patch

Helper Duties

During Shift

Pumpkins:

- When you have down time, please move pumpkins toward the front of the patch (closer to the courtyard) as they start to get thinned out.
- Check pumpkins for rot
 - Minimally rotten pumpkins should be taken to the parking lot & placed next to the white fenced trash shed (behind the hedge of bushes, along the roadside). Walk on Water Ministries will pick up the minimally rotten pumpkins to feed the animals in their care.
 - Extremely rotten pumpkins should be placed inside a black trash bag and placed in a garbage can.
- Turn pumpkins
 - Turning pumpkins helps prevent rot. If the pumpkin is sitting on its base, turn it on its side. If the pumpkin is lying on its side, place it in an upright position.

Helper Duties

During Shift

Lights:

- To turn the outside lights ON...
 - Plug in extension cord (in socket box) on the east side pillars on the front porch.
 - Go into the patch...on the right side of the building (west side), plug in the extension cord at the socket box along the wall.
- To turn the outside lights OFF...
 - Unplug extension cord on front porch pillar (east side).
 - Go into patch...on the right side of the building (west side), unplug the extension cord at the socket box along the wall.
- Turn the pumpkin patch lights OFF at the end of the LAST shift (7pm).

Music:

- Plug in speaker
- Give Alexa a minute to turn on, and say “Alexa, play Hillsong Worship”
- Once the music has started, say “Alexa, loop the playlist.”
- To turn off, just unplug the speaker.

During Shift

Closing Shift:

- A church member will meet you at 7pm to help close up shop and lock up the church.
- Turn the pumpkin patch lights OFF at the end of the LAST shift (7pm). *see page 4 for details*
- The helper table can stay out overnight, please keep the wooden picture frame containing the instructions, the laminated pricing sheet, and the donation jar (please make sure the jar is empty) on the table as well.
- Make sure there are \$100 in small bills (10s, 5s, 1s only) in the cash box. All other cash collected can get folded up with the tally sheet you marked on for today, and placed in the marked cabinet at the Welcome Desk. The cash box can also be placed in the marked cabinet at the Welcome Desk.
- Place a new tally sheet on the clipboard for tomorrow's helpers (you'll find these at the back of the Helper Notebook).
- The music speaker, plastic bin, helper notebook, clipboard, pillows, blankets, bowling pins/balls, & other loose games can make their way inside for the night.

Pumpkin Patch

Pumpkins are our gift to the community...

- Each family is welcome to pick out 2 pumpkins & each child may pick 1 small pumpkin of their choice (spookie, perfect pumpkin, or snowflake)
- If a family would like more than the 2 allotted pumpkins, they are welcome to purchase them! To figure the cost, see the pumpkin pricing sheet (page 7 & 8).
- Please mark EVERYTHING that leaves the patch, whether it's gifted or purchased! (see the tally sheet on the clipboard)
- A cash box is available for making change should someone need to purchase pumpkins.
- All monies should be kept in the cash box and 1 helper should remain at the table with the cash box at all times.
- Bug spray, gloves, extra trash bags, & stickers are in the clear bin.
- Church front doors are open for bathroom use.
