- **“Discipling in the Little Moments”**, an article by Sarah Free, writer and editor for Awana, gives 5 simple ideas on how we can point our kids to Jesus throughout the week.
- **God’s Daring Dozen** by Brian J. Wright and John R. Brown are excellent picture books geared towards kids to help them learn about the minor prophets and how each book points to Jesus. The current sermon series is on the minor prophets so these books are also a fantastic resource for parents to continue to grow and share with their family about what they’re learning from the message each week.
