### **DIGGING DEEPER:**

1. What are the implications of Jesus' invitation, "follow me?" Why are there so few conversations among the church about what it really means to follow Jesus?
2. What are some of the "nets" you have walked away from and what are some "nets" you need to walk away from?
3. In what ways is Jesus' call to self denial so much stronger than we have been taught? Renouncing your right to be the king of your life rather than giving up some of the sinful actions and attitudes that you struggle with.
4. How is praying the sinners prayer and surrendering your personal autonomy and authority to Jesus completely different?
5. What does it look like practically to crucify that part of you that strives against Jesus' leadership in your life every day?
6. How reassuring is it to know that Jesus graciously gives us the opportunity to follow Him everyday rather than demanding perfection over the course of a lifetime?
7. In light of Easter take a few minutes to talk about some of the sacrifices Jesus made for us in life and in death. How should that impact the way we live for Him?
