



Weekly Sermon Based Discussion Questions

DIGGING DEEPER:

1. Both the angels and Jesus pointed people back to Scripture. Why do you think Scripture is so central to encountering Christ, and how can we become more consistent students of it?
2. The disciples said, “Did not our hearts burn within us... while He opened to us the Scriptures?” What does it look like for your heart to “burn” for God’s Word today?
3. Jesus took them to Scripture and taught about Himself from the Old Testament. How does viewing all of Scripture through the lens of Christ change the way you read and understand it?
4. The disciples urged Jesus to stay with them, even when it was inconvenient. What are some practical ways we can pursue deeper time with Christ, even when life feels busy?
5. Their eyes were opened in the breaking of bread and fellowship. How does community and shared spiritual practice help us encounter Jesus more fully?
6. After encountering the risen Christ, the disciples were changed and sent on mission. What might it look like for your life to reflect a true encounter with Jesus this week?
7. Their circumstances didn’t change, but their perspective did. How does encountering Christ change the way we view our current struggles, even if nothing around us improves?
8. Jesus said they were “slow of heart to believe.” What are some areas in your life where you know God’s truth, but struggle to fully believe or trust it?
