DIGGING DEEPER:

1. In Luke 15, the Pharisees complained about sinners approaching Jesus. In what ways can we, as church people, have a negative attitude toward sinners who need to come to Jesus?
2. The Pharisees believed Jesus was attracting the "wrong crowd." How often, after being saved for years, do we lose sight of the fact that we were once the "wrong crowd?"
3. How actively are you participating in Jesus' mission of "seeking and saving the lost?" Do you ever intentionally spend time with "sinners?"
4. What does the church need to do individually to care more collectively about "the one?"
5. Take a moment and share your own personal testimony of when you were the one, and Jesus the Shepherd found you.
6. What are spiritual things that the church should be called to celebrate collectively? (share as many as possible)
7. Have you ever felt like "the one" that was overlooked? Shouldn't that awareness of how that feels drive us to go out of our way to care for "the one"?
