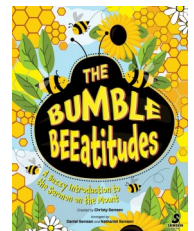

So often, we think we're too busy to carve out time to meet a need. I'll be honest; sometimes I feel that way too. Kierra's 25th birthday fell on the Saturday of Easter weekend. I was busy with family in town, but I knew she didn't have anyone planning a lunch, baking a cake, or celebrating her day with her. All day Friday and Saturday morning, God gently nudged my heart to go see her. I'll admit I wrestled with it, but God kept nudging. So, I went. I picked up a gift and a cake and drove across town. Kierra was dressed up, ready to celebrate a birthday lunch alone. When I handed her the cake, a simple gift, and a birthday hug, her face lit up with a big smile in a way that brought a smile to my own face. In that moment, God quietly reminded me that this moment was about far more than the cake. It was about her feeling remembered and cared for on her special day. Isn't that the heart of the gospel? Sacrifice for others. On a weekend when we were celebrating the resurrection of Christ, I was reminded that Jesus meets us in our loneliness, pursues us when we feel forgotten, and calls us to do the same for others. What felt like an interruption to my plans became a sacred moment, one where love showed up in simple yet meaningful way for someone else.

That simple act of obedience became a gift, not only to Kierra, but to me.

Back-to-School, Packed with Love

Join us in collecting backpacks filled with school supplies to support low-income children. With the high cost of living, it can be difficult for families to provide new backpacks and essential supplies for the school year. This simple act of generosity and care can make a meaningful difference in helping a child be prepared and confident as they begin a new school year with everything they need. **The Raleigh Baptist Association will be accepting filled backpacks throughout the summer. Backpacks may be dropped off starting the week of June 22 and ending August 13.** Distribution will be made to year round students as well as traditional calendar students.

Below, you will find a list of suggested school supplies. In addition, if you would like to include a gift card in the bag for kids' clothes, this would be a blessing. Starting the school year with new clothes builds confidence and a strong sense of self-worth, which is important for children and youth, especially those already facing hardships and struggles.

A few helpful tips:

- Supply lists are organized below by grade level for your convenience and based off most frequently requested items by local schools.
- Once your backpack is complete, please label it elementary, middle, or high school to help us distribute them efficiently.
