You know we've done it – right here in one of the most blessed countries this world has ever seen.

We've complained, whined, grumbled or otherwise expressed displeasure at our lot in life. For sure, there's a lot to be dissatisfied with. You and I could come up with a dozen legitimate reasons to be concerned: Situations in our personal life, tragedies that have occurred in the past (or are even now occurring), the socio-political situation, on and on.

But one pundit reminds us of this: *"The older I get, the more I realize how important it is to be grateful for everything I already have [instead of crying] about all the things I don't have . . . some people would kill to have your life."*

But overall, life is pretty good for us. Let us instead, give thanks, be grateful, and not grumbling. We may not have everything we want, but as our pundit said, *"some people would kill to have your life."*
