Talking To Your Children About Easter

You don't need to be a Bible expert. You don't need perfect answers. If you'll be present, read a little, ask a few questions and listen, you can help your child grasp the deeper significance of the resurrection. Here is a guide to help you have this important conversation.

Read Together: Matthew 28:1-6

Ask:

What part of this story stood out to you?

How do you think the women felt before they knew Jesus was alive?

How did they feel after they saw what happened?

What do you think it means that Jesus is alive?

Read Together: 1 Peter 1:3

Interaction:

Have your child pretend to be (1) A butterfly coming out of a cocoon, (2) a seed planted that becomes a flower, (3) Jesus lying still, then coming back to life.

Ask:

What do you think it means that Jesus has given us a "new birth"?

What do you think it means for Jesus to give us a "living hope"?

Review: In the lesson today, we saw several sad words that describe Jesus' death that turned into happy words because Jesus is now alive. Give the child the top word, and see if they can remember the bottom word.

Ask:

Which of these joyful words sounds like something you would like to have in your life?

When is a time you feel afraid, and how could Jesus help you be brave?

What is some "good news" you can share with someone this week?

Pray Together:

"God, we thank you that Jesus is alive. Thank you that you turn fear into courage and sorrow into joy. Help us to trust you and to share your good news with others. In Jesus' name, Amen."

Hablando con tus hijos sobre la Pascua

No necesitas ser un experto en la Biblia. No necesitas respuestas perfectas. Si estás presente, lees un poco, haces algunas preguntas y escuchas, puedes ayudar a tu hijo a comprender el significado más profundo de la resurrección. Aquí tienes una guía para ayudarte a tener esta conversación importante.

Lean juntos: Mateo 28:1-6

Pregunten:

- ¿Qué parte de esta historia te llamó más la atención?
- ¿Cómo crees que se sentían las mujeres antes de saber que Jesús estaba vivo?
- ¿Cómo se sintieron después de ver lo que pasó?
- ¿Qué crees que significa que Jesús está vivo?

Lean juntos: 1 Pedro 1:3

Interacción:

Haz que tu hijo finja ser (1) una mariposa saliendo de un capullo, (2) una semilla plantada que se convierte en una flor, (3) Jesús acostado sin moverse, y luego volviendo a la vida.

Pregunten:

- ¿Qué crees que significa que Jesús nos ha dado un “nuevo nacimiento”?
- ¿Qué crees que significa que Jesús nos da una “esperanza viva”?

Repaso: En la lección de hoy, vimos varias palabras tristes que describen la muerte de Jesús y que se convirtieron en palabras felices porque Jesús ahora está vivo. Dile a tu hijo la palabra de arriba y ve si puede recordar la palabra de abajo.
