Singing Because of the Storm

“Let everything that breathes sing praises to the Lord! Praise the Lord!” Psalms 150:6 NLT

While I was running one morning last week, it was raining as I passed the retention pond, and I heard an amazing sound—the singing of the green tree frogs. It reminded me of all the beach trips that Teresa and I made because they would always sing during and after the rain.

It also reminded me of another special trip. We were gifted a week-long trip to Bald Head Island off the coast of North Carolina. That week, a tropical storm came through and dumped a lot of rain. I sat on the back porch looking out over the marshes and listened to the thousands of frogs, which were deafening and beautiful, praising God during and after the storm.

Why were they singing because of the storm? That was the way they were created. These frogs sing *in* the storms primarily *because* damp conditions help them travel safely and provide perfect, predator-free puddles for laying eggs. Providence. Life was beautiful, good, and so happy on that day.

I was reminded, thinking about the “noise” of those frogs on Bald Head Island and the studies that I am doing now to co-teach on the wilderness journeys throughout the Bible in the Fall, that even in the downpours of the storms of life, I have a reason to praise Him from the top of my lungs! Why? That was what we were made to do. After all, He is using those storms to bring us safely one day back into His Garden.

So, we sing in and because of our storms. So, life is good, beautiful, and happy on this day as well. Providence.
