# The Eyes of the Lord

Psalms 33 is a wonderful passage on God's watchfulness over His creation, especially over those who revere Him, and His provision on their behalf.

For instance, the Psalmist states . . .

*From heaven the Lord looks down and sees all mankind; from his dwelling place he watches all who live on earth— he who forms the hearts of all, who considers everything they do.*

And in Vv 18-21 he says . . .

*But the eyes of the Lord are on those who fear him, on those whose hope is in his unfailing love to deliver them from death and keep them alive in famine. We wait in hope for the Lord; he is our help and our shield. In him our hearts rejoice for we trust in his holy name.*

God is watching over the affairs of the earth, whether war or peace, feast or famine, persecution or tranquility, dismay or death. He knows what is happening over all His creation.

The Psalmist says . . .

*The Lord loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of his unfailing love . . . . But the plans of the Lord stand firm forever, the purposes of his heart through all generations. ~ Vv 5, 11*

No wonder he says in v1, *Sing joyfully to the Lord, you righteous; it is fitting for the upright to praise him.*
