We Did It!

I read in a recent devotional reading about a movie called “*The Greatest Game Ever Played*.” The movie is about Francis Ouimet, a 20-year-old golfer, who won the 1913 US Open with the help of a 10-year-old caddie named Eddie. Ironically, Francis had served as a caddie himself in the same event as a young boy. After accomplishing the unthinkable by sinking the winning playoff putt on the 18th hole, Francis ecstatically proclaimed, “We did it!” Francis acknowledged that while he played extraordinarily well, he actually won because of the help and encouragement of his 10-year-old caddie.

Now I don’t know about you, but I think that if a lot of us were in that situation, we might be more likely to exclaim, “I did it.” Paul writes in Romans 12:10 that we are to “*Honor one another above yourselves.*” “We” is a lot more powerful than “Me!” Jesus desires for us to pick up our cross and follow Him. We must die to self every day. And usually this isn’t very easy as it conflicts with our worldly human nature. We must look after not only our own interests, but also the interests of others. It is not we who live, but Christ who lives in us.

God can use us best when we sacrifice our own interests for the interests of others. Let’s devote ourselves to one another in love and honor one another above ourselves. Then we will truly value We over Me.
