## Important CDP Information

### CDP News:

School is off to a great start with 237 enrolled. We are so excited to have your child with us. We have a group of caring staff members trying hard to make sure that we provide the best program we can offer you. Thank you for your patience through the transitions we face as we start school each year.

We have an open door policy and appreciate all feedback so please do not hesitate to contact me or stop to see Ms. Reagan, our afternoon supervisor, at the front desk. We cannot fix issues that we do not know about.

Compu-Child will kick off this month. Mrs. Lisa comes each 1st and 3rd Wednesday of the month. Computer is for rooms 134-143.

### Sick Policy:

As usual, there has been some sickness that comes with the start of school each year. We ask that you keep us updated of any absences and inform us if a child is out due to specific symptoms that we need to share with other parents. We want to have full disclosure with parents, and will share this on Brightwheel. We will be cleaning rooms on a regular schedule, and assessing for symptoms while children are in our care.

### Speech Screening:

We are fortunate to have Libby Patton conducting speech screenings this month for children two and older. This is to help identify children who might need further speech and/or language assessment. Please return your permission slip to us if you are interested.

### Picture Days:

We will be having individual school pictures on Tuesday-Thursday, Sept. 8th-10th. These will be done by Pixels Photography, which is the same company as last year. Each willing child will be automatically photographed.

- Send some extra clothes to school so your child will have them if needed.
- Your child needs to have eaten breakfast if they come in after 8:00. Please be at school by 8:45 each day.
- There is a wheelchair/stroller safety lane under the drop off area. Please do not block it with your cars so that it can be used.

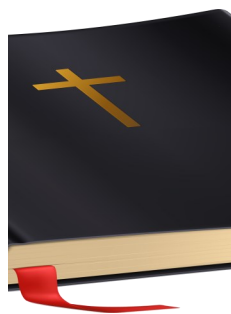
