IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

HANGING OUT:

Can you be a Christian and still not live for Jesus?



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

What are some ways we can stay close to Jesus?

Do you think God wants us to have happy lives?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this series' memory verse, John 14:6. Make sure they understand about becoming a Christian and being forgiven for their sins. Make sure they also understand that once we become Christians, we need to live daily in and for Christ, by spending time in prayer, praise, being in the Bible, and being obedient.



PARENT TIME:
