### THIS WEEK'S LESSON: HOW YOU SHOULD PRAY



#### IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Prayer was an important part of Jesus' life on earth, and it should be an important part of our lives. Just like you talk to your friends or family every day, prayer is simply how we talk to God. Jesus showed his disciples – and us – how we should pray and how important prayer is. Matthew 6:5-15, Prayer



#### HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

If there's a copy of the Lord's Prayer on display in your home, show it to the kids so they know where it is. If it's not on display, consider printing a copy to post on the fridge for the next few weeks during this series.



#### AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

#### AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

*"This is how you should pray. Our Father in heaven, may your name be honored. May your kingdom come. May what you want to happen be done on earth as it is done in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. And forgive us our sins, just as we also have forgiven those who sin against us. Keep us from sinning when we are tempted. Save us from the evil one." Matthew 6:9-13 (NIRV)*



#### PARENT TIME:

What you need to know: Every good relationship depends on great communication. We must communicate with God if we want to grow our relationship with Him, and prayer is how we do that. Encourage your kids to make prayer a daily habit, and strive to make it a habit of yours as well.
