### THIS WEEK'S LESSON: FORGIVE



#### IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home: God's forgiveness is available to everyone who accepts it and puts their faith in Jesus. Just as we have been forgiven, God expects us to extend forgiveness to others. Matthew 6:12 & Matthew 18:21-35, The Parable of the Unmerciful Servant



#### HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real: Share with your kids any big debts you have, be they credit card, house, car, etc. Ask them what debt Jesus has paid for us.



#### AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Why was the servant with the debt punished by his master?
- What debt has Jesus forgiven for us?
- Why does God want us to forgive others?



#### AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

*"This, then, is how you should pray: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one." Matthew 6:9-13 (NIV)*



#### PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

If God has forgiven us so much, how can we not forgive in return? Ask God to give you and your children forgiving hearts so you can share God's forgiveness with others.
