IN THE CAR:

Ask your kid, "How was Saul's life in danger? Who provided help to save him and how?"



HANGING OUT:

Play a game of paper basketball. Ball up some scrap paper and use a waste paper basket. See how many shots your kid can get in a row. Cheer them on! Afterwards, ask your child, "How did it feel to have me cheering you on? How is that a lot like knowing God is with us, helping and encouraging us?"



AT DINNER:

AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:
