5 Simple Ways to Make This Week's Lesson Stick



IN THE CAR:

Ask your kid, "How did Moses lean on God and his friends for help during the battle against the Amalekites?"



HANGING OUT:

At home, give your child a list of chores to help you with this week. Encourage them to ask questions about how to do the chores or ask for help if they are struggling. Thank them for helping you and say, "It's good to be able to have your help!"



AT DINNER:

Why is it important to help one another?

In what ways do we need God's help? Lean on God?

Have you asked God for His help lately? Remember He is always there!



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"Be humble in front of the Lord. And he will lift you up." James 4:10 (NIRV)



PARENT TIME:

Last week's lesson on humility leads us to this week's lesson that God's SVPs aren't afraid to offer help or ask for help! (SVP – Second-most Valuable Players next to Jesus!) God loves us, and He is there for us. Like in the game of baseball, when we grip tightly to a bat to hit a home run, Moses gripped tightly to God's staff, depending on Him to save them in battle. He also leaned on his friends for help. It takes humility to admit we need help, but when we do, we open ourselves up to healthy, loving relationships with God and with others! Encourage your child to admit their need for help and also to show kindness in helping their siblings or friends this week!
