IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home: This week we talked about Ananias and Sapphira. Just like all sins, lying always has a cost. The Bible tells us that the wages of sin is death and Ananias and Sapphira had to pay the price for their lies much sooner than they thought. Their story does not mean anyone who tells a lie will instantly drop dead. But it does show us that anyone who lies - or cheats, or steals, or hates someone or commits any other sin - will eventually die. But Jesus, who is the way, the TRUTH, and the life, has made a way for us to be forgiven of the big cost of our sin, through his death on the cross. Acts 5:1-11, Ananias and Sapphira



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:
Ask your kids why lying is a sin.
