THIS WEEK'S LESSON:



IN THE CAR:

On the drive home, ask your child what he learned about this week: Why is it so important to pray to God? Can we ask God to help us? God wants us to ask for help. Talking to Him in prayer helps us to be ready to serve Him wherever we go! This is why it's so important to pray to Him every day! Acts 1:1-14, Jesus Taken Up into Heaven



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kid to pray in as many different places that they can today. At school, at home, in the car, at an afterschool activity, etc. Have them keep track of all the places they prayed and report back to you!

Ask: What were some things you asked God to help you with today?



AT DINNER:

- Here are some great discussion starters:
- Did you know that Jesus prayed too?
- Why do you think God wants us to talk to Him?
- Is there a special place that you like to go to pray on your own?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." Matthew 28:19 (NIV)



PARENT TIME:
