THIS WEEK'S LESSON:



IN THE CAR:

On the drive home, ask your child what he learned about this week: Who does Jesus offer salvation to? Every sinner. It doesn't matter how rotten we've been; Jesus offers us a new life. We have a choice to accept God's gift or not. Matthew 26:14-16, Judas Agrees to Betray Jesus, Luke 23:39-43, The Thief on the Cross, Matthew 28:1-10, The Resurrection



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your child if they have realized and admitted the fact that they have sinned. Ask your child if they have prayed to ask Jesus to forgive them for their sins.



AT DINNER:

- Why do you think Jesus forgave the thief?
- What choice do we have to make in order to be followers of Jesus?
- Would you like to pray the prayer of salvation?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"The free gift of God's grace makes us right with him. Christ Jesus paid the price to set us free." Romans 3:24 (NIRV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

God loves us so much that He sent His son to die for us. We all have the choice to accept the gift of salvation, or to turn away from God. Pray for your child as often as you can, that they will be a follower of Jesus and allow God to change them to be more and more like Him. Praying for your child on your own is as equally important as praying in front of them so that they can hear you praying for them. This shows your child how much you value them and how important it is that they are a follower of Jesus.
