They cannot call on Christ unless they hear.



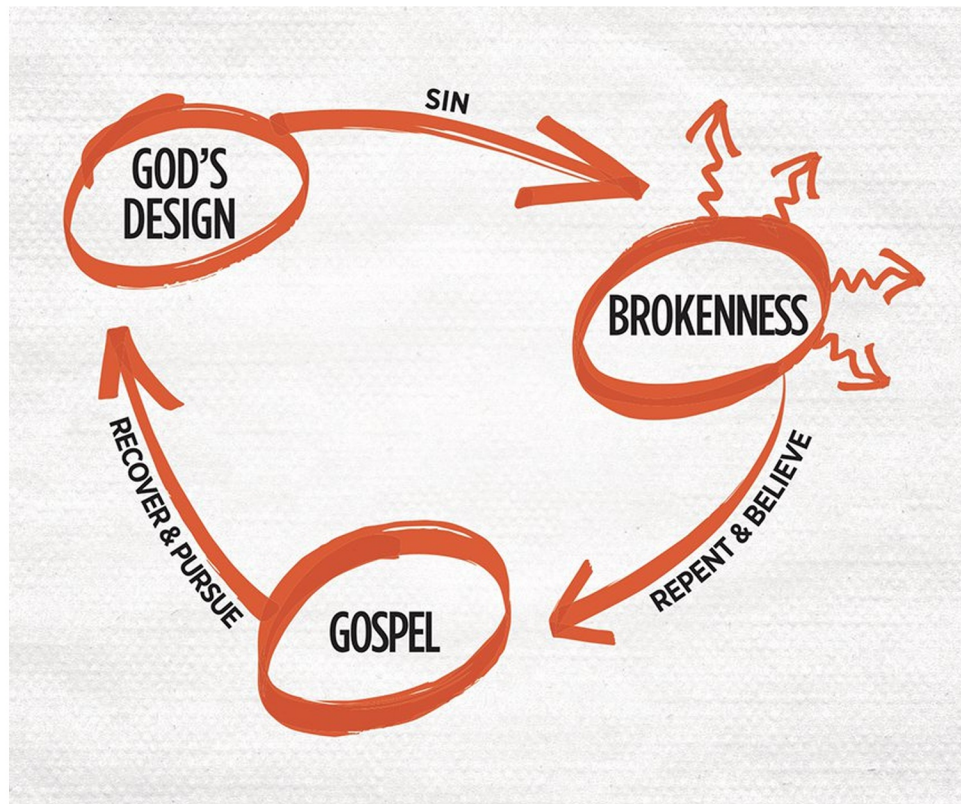
You Can Do It

STARTER

Can I show you a picture?

KEY VERSE

Romans 5:8

How to Walk Through It

Keep it conversational. Draw as you explain.

1

God's Design

God created the world good and designed us for relationship with Him.

2

Brokenness

Sin moves us away from God and into brokenness.

3

Gospel

Jesus died and rose again to rescue us from sin.

4

Repent & Believe

We turn from sin and trust Christ as Savior and Lord.

5

Recover & Pursue

God restores us to pursue His design and make disciples.



Your Story

The Gospel becomes personal when you tell what Christ has done.

Before Christ

What was I trusting in?

Meeting Christ

How did I repent and believe?

Since Christ

What has Jesus changed?



Acts 26 Framework

Paul told who he was, how he met Christ, and what Christ called him to do. Your testimony can follow the same simple pattern.

Aim for three minutes. Clear. Honest. Christ-centered.

What did I believe? What was missing?

2

How I came to Christ

Who shared with me? What did I understand?

3

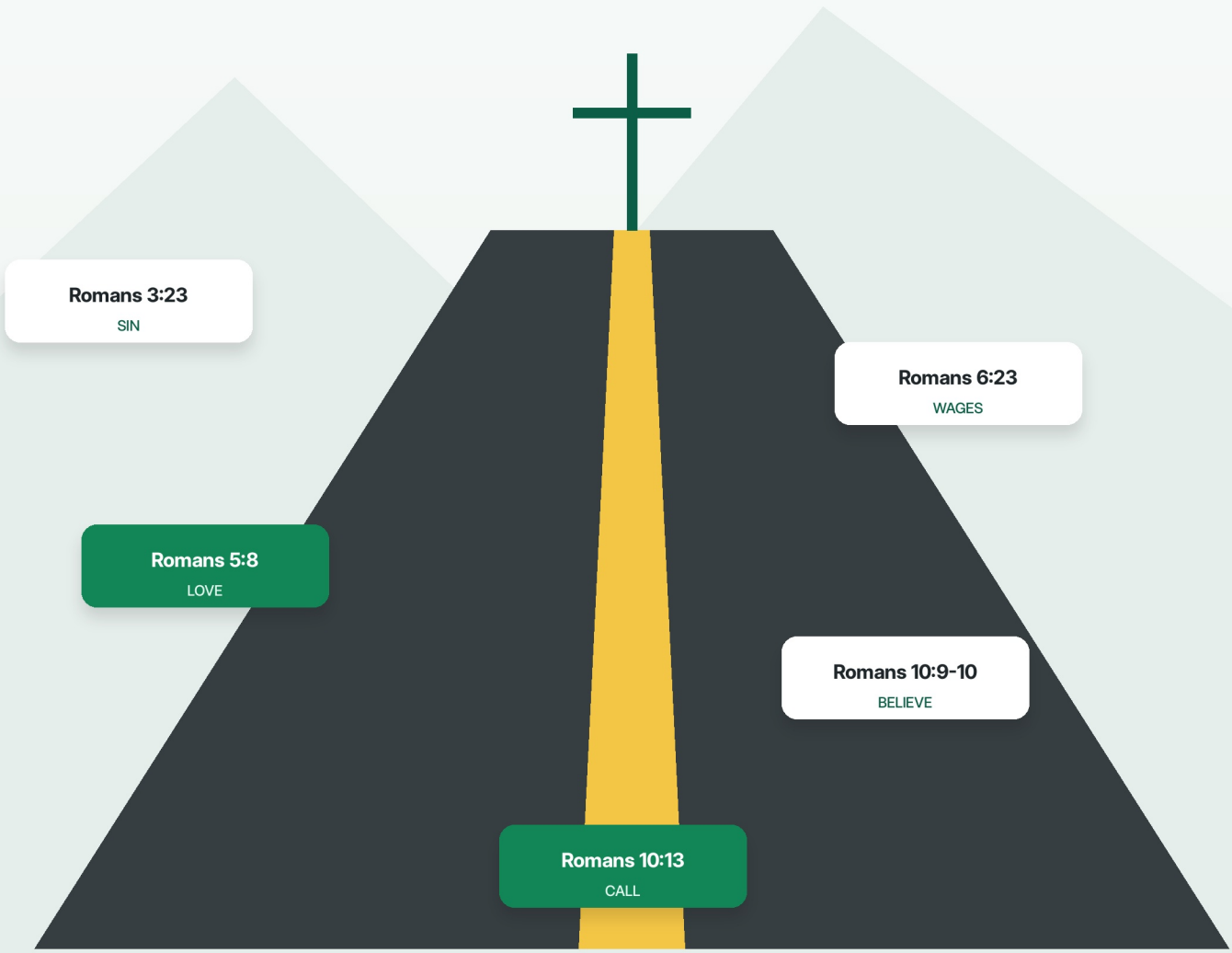
My life since Christ

What has He changed? What hope do I have now?

Tip: Do not make yourself the hero. Make Jesus the hero.

The Roman Road

Let Scripture walk someone through the Gospel.



Five Stops on the Road

Read the verses. Ask what each one says. Invite a response.

3:23

Romans 3:23

Everyone has sinned.

6:23

Romans 6:23

Sin earns death, but God gives eternal life.

5:8

Romans 5:8

Christ died for us while we were still sinners.

10:9-10

Romans 10:9-10

We confess Jesus as Lord and believe God raised Him.

10:13

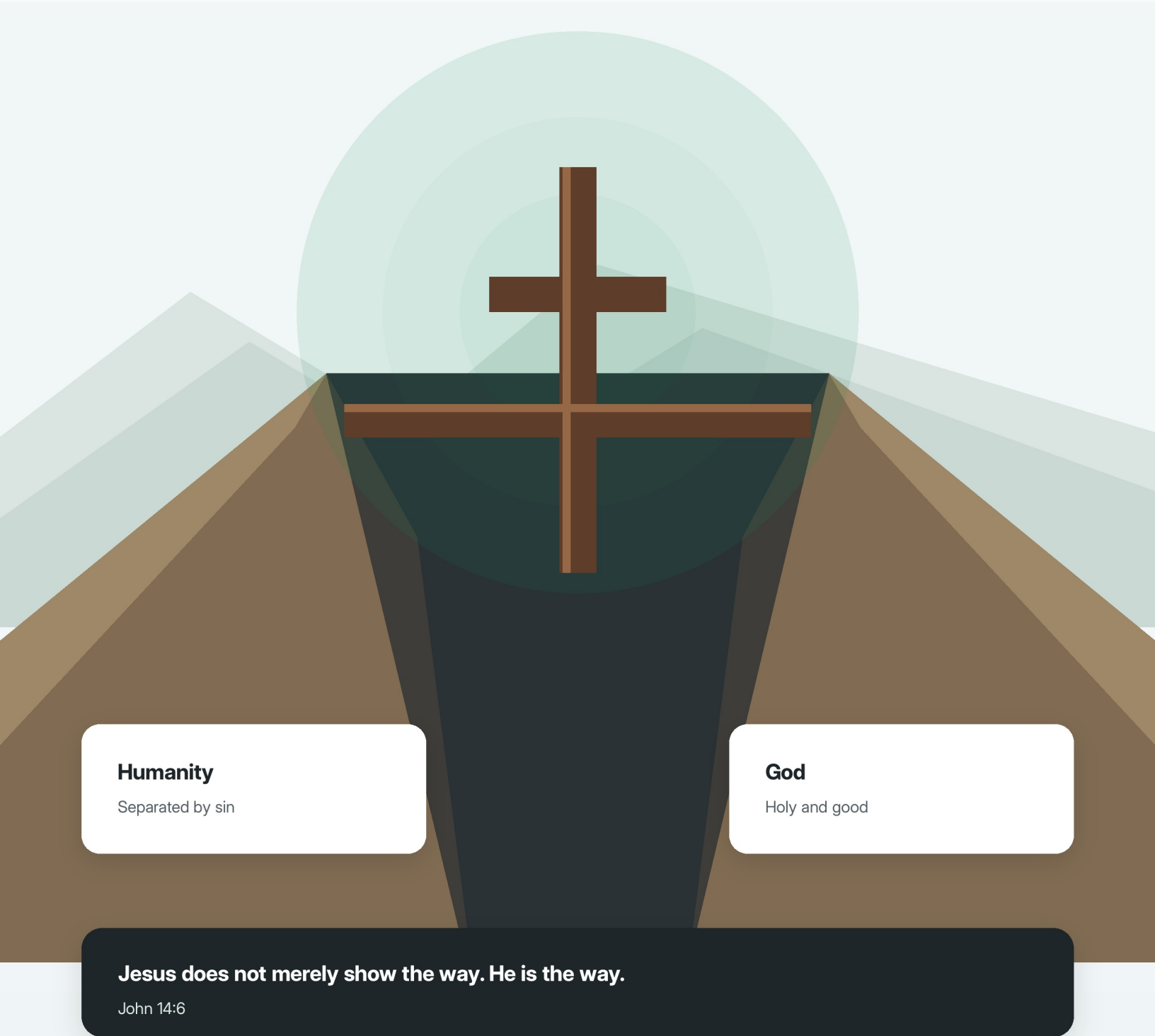
Romans 10:13

Everyone who calls on the Lord will be saved.



The Bridge Illustration

Sin separates. Jesus makes the way.



Explain the Gap

This method helps people see why the cross matters.

God is holy

God is perfect, righteous, and good.

Sin separates

Our sin creates a gap we cannot cross by effort or religion.

Christ bridges

Jesus died in our place and rose again so we can be reconciled to God.

We respond

We repent and believe the Gospel.

Conversation Starter

Can I show you why Jesus had to die and what His death makes possible?

One-Verse Evangelism

Use John 3:16 as a simple Gospel map.

God
SOURCE

God initiates salvation.

Loved
MOTIVE

The Gospel begins with God's love.

World
NEED

The offer is for sinners like us.

Gave
GIFT

The Father gave His Son.

Believes
RESPONSE

We trust Christ, not ourselves.

Life
PROMISE

Eternal life begins in Christ.

John 3:16 God loved. God gave. We believe. We receive life.
