It is always a blessing to take a moment at the end of every year to celebrate what God has done for us and what God has done through us. This report highlights those events and blessings. Here are a few things for us to be grateful about and to pray for continued success in the coming year:

We serve our community each week through Al Anon, AA and Medway's Cancer Support Group. This year we added a Grief Support Group and a Kinship Foster Care Support Group.

We send mentors into the local elementary schools each week to meet with at-risk students who need a friendly face, a listening ear and some extra help with schoolwork.

Our clothing closet reopened following the pandemic and is serving those in need weekly alongside our food pantry.

Our VBS Sports and Arts Camp had another amazing year with 528 students and over 200 adult servants for a week of fun, worship and learning about Jesus.

Over 100 volunteers packed 14,000 meals which were sent to our partners in Haiti.

Over 120 teens and adult leaders went to the Christ In Youth discipleship conference.

We sent adults on mission trips to Arizona, Kentucky and Detroit.

We are humbled with the blessings that God is pouring out on us. Please pray as we begin 2023 that we will continue to be faithful to the calling on this congregation and that we will share the good news of God's love with all people, build radical followers of Jesus Christ, and reach the world.
