- What was one highlight from your week or something that brought you joy?
- What is one challenge you faced this week, and how did you respond to it?
- What is one thought, phrase, or moment from this week's message that has stayed with you throughout the week?

HAVE A VOLUNTEER READ A DIFFERENT SCRIPTURE PASSAGE FROM THIS WEEK'S BULLETIN NOTES.

- What do you notice in this passage that you may not have noticed during this week's service?
- How does this passage challenge or encourage you personally?
- Why do you think this Scripture was important to the overall message this week?

Every passage of Scripture reveals something about God's heart and His desire for His people. As we study together, we grow by listening to God's Word and learning from one another's perspectives.

HAVE A VOLUNTEER READ A THIRD SCRIPTURE PASSAGE FROM THIS WEEK'S BULLETIN NOTES.

- How does this passage help you better understand the main application of this week's sermon?
- What principle from this Scripture is most relevant to your current season of life?
- If someone missed this week's message, what would you want them to understand from this passage?

God never intends for us to simply hear His Word. He invites us to respond in faith and allow His truth to transform the way we live each day.

APPLICATION

- **Based on this week's message, what is one specific step of obedience God is calling you to take this week?**
- **Which point from this week's sermon do you most need to remember over the next few days, and why?**
- **How can this group encourage or pray for you as you seek to apply this week's message?**

Ask for a volunteer to close the group by praying over the issues discussed and any prayer requests that were mentioned.
