# A LETTER FROM MIKE

2021 has been another challenging yet incredible year because God is faithful. It is times like these we are more grateful for your support and your prayers. There has never been a better time to be more faithful and supportive of the church. God has continued to bring new people to Medway and do new things in our congregation. Our online service has allowed many of you who are not able to be in person continue to watch from home.

We had many ministries return after a histus due to the pandemic:

VBS returned in July and we had over 560 children and 260 servants. We held Wednesday Night Classes with over 140 folks turning out to grow in their knowledge and relationship with Christ.

The Easter Egg Hunt and Breekfast with Santa were both back in person this year. We were blessed to be able to serve several thousand people through those events.

Our mentoring ministry has been able to meet in person again with students at Park Layne Elementary School and touch the lives of children.

Many ministries continue to grow and serve those in our community. Our food paritry has fed 931 families so far this year – 10,098 people and 464,292 meets. We held our second annual cost drive and givesway in November and blessed those in need with 400 coats. Our breakfast ministry served its 200,000th breakfast in November and continues to be a welcoming component to inviting new people.

We hosted 5 blood drives and collected 121 units of blood which can save up to 363 lives.

43 people committed their lives to Christ through baptism bringing our total baptisms in the last 18 years to 806/

We served our community each week through AA, Al Anon and cancer support groups.

We provided Christmas gifts to over 250 children whose parents are in prison through Angel Tree Prison Fellowship.

God is still moving at Medway Church and I can't thank you enough for your prayers and commitment. Our job is to change the world. As we work to do that, God continues to pour out blessings beyond all that we can hope or imagine. I hope this report will affirm to you that your church is making a difference in the lives of those we touch.
