What A Savior

Our Overcomer

Matthew 20:17-19 “As Jesus was going up to Jerusalem, he took the twelve disciples aside privately and told them what was going to happen to him. ‘Listen,’ he said, ‘we’re going up to Jerusalem, where the Son of Man will be betrayed to the leading priests and the teachers of religious law. They will sentence him to die. Then they will hand him over to the Romans to be mocked, flogged with a whip, and crucified. But on the third day he will be raised from the dead.’”

Mark 10:32 “They were now on the way up to Jerusalem, and Jesus was walking ahead of them. The disciples were filled with awe, and the people following behind were overwhelmed with fear. Taking the twelve disciples aside, Jesus once more began to describe everything that was about to happen to him.”

Betrayed By _____ “Listen,” he said, “we’re going up to Jerusalem, where the Son of Man will be betrayed to the leading priests and the teachers of religious law. They will sentence him to die.” (v.18)

Matthew 23:25-26 “What sorrow awaits you teachers of religious law and you Pharisees. **Hypocrites!** For you are so careful to clean the outside of the cup and the dish, but inside you are filthy—full of greed and self-indulgence! **You blind Pharisee!** First wash the inside of the cup and the dish, and then the outside will become clean, too.”

John 19:7 The Jewish leaders replied, “By our law he ought to die because he called himself the Son of God.”

Mocked By _____ “Then they will hand him over to the Romans to be mocked...” (v.19a)

Acts 2:23 “But God knew what would happen, and his prearranged plan was carried out when Jesus was betrayed. With the help of **lawless Gentiles**, you nailed him to a cross and killed him.”

Matthew 27:29 “They wove thorn branches into a crown and put it on his head, and they placed a reed stick in his right hand as a scepter. Then they knelt before him in mockery and taunted, ‘Hail! King of the Jews!’”

Killed By A _____ “Then they will hand him over to the Romans to be mocked, flogged with a whip, and crucified.” (V.19)
1 Corinthians 1:23 “So when we preach that Christ was crucified, the Jews are offended and the Gentiles say it’s all nonsense.”
