Hebrews 10:36 When may you receive what is promised? When you have done the will of God
Hebrews 10:36 What may you receive? What is promised
Hebrews 10:37 Who will come and will not delay? The coming one
Hebrews 10:38 Who shall live by faith? My righteous one
Hebrews 10:38 By what shall my righteous one live? Faith
Hebrews 10:38 If what does my soul have no pleasure in him? (If) He shrinks back

 Mark 1:4 How did John appear? Baptizing in the wilderness and proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins
 Mark 1:5 Who were going out to him and were being baptized [**OR** What were going out to him and being baptized]? All the country of Judea and all Jerusalem
 Mark 1:5 In what were all the country of Judea and all Jerusalem being baptized? The river Jordan
 Mark 1:5 Confessing what were all the country of Judea and Jerusalem being baptized? Their sins
 Mark 1:6 Who was clothed with camel's hair [**OR** Who wore a leather belt **OR** Who ate locusts and wild honey]? John
 Mark 1:6 With what was John clothed? Camel's hair
