John 4:1 What did Jesus learn? That the Pharisees had heard that Jesus was making and baptizing more disciples than John
John 4:1 What had the Pharisees heard? (That) Jesus was making and baptizing more disciples than John.
John 4:2 Who did not baptize? Jesus (himself)
John 4:2 Who did baptize? (only) his disciples
John 4:3 Where did he leave? Judea
John 4:3 For where did he depart again? Galilee
John 4:4 Where did he have to pass through? Samaria
John 4:5 To where did he come? A town of Samaria called Sychar
John 4:5 What was a town of Samaria called? Sychar
John 4:5 Who had given the field to his son Joseph? Jacob
John 4:5 To whom had Jacob given the field? His son Joseph
John 4:6 Whose well was there? Jacob's
John 4:6 What was there? Jacob's well (the well)
John 4:6 When was it? About the sixth hour
John 4:6 Who was wearied from his journey **OR** Who was sitting beside the well)? Jesus
John 4:6 Where was Jesus sitting? Beside the well
John 4:7 From where did a woman come (to draw water)? Samaria
John 4:7 What did Jesus say to her? Give me a drink
John 4:7 Who came to draw water? A woman from Samaria
John 4:7 What did a woman from Samaria come to draw? Water
John 4:8 Where had his disciples gone (away) to buy food? Into the city
John 4:8 Who had gone away into the city (to buy food)? His disciples
John 4:9 Who said to him? The Samaritan woman
John 4:9 What did the Samaritan woman say to him? How is it that you, a Jew, ask for a drink from me, (a woman of Samaria)
John 4:9 Who have no dealings with Samaritans? Jews
John 4:9 With whom do Jews have not dealings? Samaritans
John 4:10 Who answered her? Jesus
John 4:10 What did Jesus answer her? "If you knew the gift of God, and who it is that is saying to you, 'Give me a drink,' you would have asked him, and he would have given you living water."
John 4:11 What is the well? Deep
John 4:11 Who said to him? The woman
John 4:11 What do you have to draw water with? Nothing
John 4:11 What did the woman say to him? Sir, you have nothing to draw water with, and the well is deep. Where do you get that living water?
John 4:12 Who gave us the well **OR** Who drank from it (himself)? (our father) Jacob (he) (as did his sons and his livestock)
John 4:12 What did he give us? The well
John 4:13 Who will be thirsty again? Everyone who drinks of this water
John 4:13 What will everyone who drinks of this water be? thirsty again
John 4:13 Who said to her? Jesus
John 4:14 What will the water I give him become (in him)? A spring of water (welling up to eternal life)
John 4:14 Who will never be thirsty again? Whoever drinks of the water that I will give him
John 4:14 When will whoever drinks of the water that I will give him be thirsty? Never (again)
John 4:15 Who said to him? The woman
John 4:15 What did the woman say to him? "Sir, give me this water, so that I will not be thirsty or have to come here to draw water."
John 4:15 So that what, give me this water? I will not be thirsty (or have to come here to draw water)
John 4:15 Who give me this water? Sir
John 4:15 What give me? This water
John 4:16 Who said to her? Jesus
John 4:16 Come where? Here
John 4:16 Call whom? Your husband
John 4:16 What did Jesus say to her? "Go, call your husband, and come here."
John 4:17 What did the woman answer him? I have no husband
John 4:17 Who answered him? The woman
John 4:17 Who said to her? Jesus
John 4:17 What did Jesus say to her? "You are right in saying, 'I have no husband'
John 4:17 What are you right in saying? I have no husband

John 4:18 Whom have you had? Five husbands
 John 4:18 What is the one you now have? Not your husband
 John 4:18 What is true? What you have said
 John 4:19 Who said to him? The woman
 John 4:19 What did the woman say to him? "Sir, I perceive that you are a prophet.
 John 4:19 Whom do I perceive that you are? A prophet
 John 4:20 Who worshiped on this mountain? Our fathers
 John 4:20 Where do you say is the place people ought to worship? In Jerusalem
 John 4:20 Where did our fathers worship? On this mountain
 John 4:20 What do you say? (that) In Jerusalem is the place where people ought to worship
 John 4:21 Who said to her? Jesus
 John 4:21 What is coming? The hour
 John 4:21 Who, believe me? Woman
 John 4:21 Where will you worship the Father? Neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem
 John 4:22 What is from the Jews? Salvation
 John 4:22 What do you worship? What you do not know
 John 4:22 What do we worship? What we know
 John 4:22 From whom is salvation? The Jews
 John 4:23 What is coming and is now here? The hour
 John 4:23 Who will worship the Father in spirit and truth? The true worshipers
 John 4:23 Who is seeking such people to worship him? The Father
 John 4:23 In what will the true worshippers worship the Father? Spirit and truth
 John 4:24 Who is spirit? God
 John 4:24 What is God? Spirit

 John 4:31 When were the disciples urging him? Meanwhile
 John 4:31 What were the disciples urging him (saying)? Rabbi, eat
 John 4:32 What did he say to them? "I have food to eat that you do not know about"
 John 4:32 What do I have to eat? Food
 John 4:33 Who said to one another? The disciples
 John 4:33 What did the disciples say to one another? "Has anyone brought him something to eat?"
 John 4:34 Who said to them? Jesus
 John 4:34 What is my food? To do the will of him who sent me and to accomplish his work
 John 4:34 What did Jesus say to them? "My food is to do the will of him who sent me and to accomplish his work"
 John 4:35 What do I tell you? Lift up your eyes and see that the fields are white for harvest
 John 4:35 What are the fields? White for harvest
 John 4:35 Lift up what? Your eyes
 John 4:35 See what? (that) the fields are white for harvest
 John 4:36 Who is receiving wages? The one who reaps

John 4:36 Who may rejoice together? Sower and reaper
 John 4:36 When is the one who reaps receiving wages? Already
 John 4:37 Where does the saying hold true? Here
 John 4:37 What holds true? The saying
 John 4:37 Who sows? One
 John 4:37 Who reaps? Another
 John 4:38 Who have labored? Others
 John 4:38 What have I sent you to reap? that for which you did not labor
 John 4:38 Where have you entered? Into their labor
 John 4:39 Who believed in him? Many Samaritans from that town
 John 4:39 What was the woman's testimony? He told me all that I ever did
 John 4:39 Why did many Samaritans from that town believe in him? Because of the woman's testimony
 John 4:40 Who came to him? The Samaritans
 John 4:40 When did he stay there? Two days
 John 4:40 Who asked him to stay with them? The Samaritans (They)
 John 4:41 Who believed because of his word? Many more
 John 4:41 Why did many more believe? Because of his word
 John 4:41 To whom did they say? The woman
 John 4:42 What did they say to the woman? "It is no longer because of what you said that we believe, (for we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this is indeed the Savior of the world.)"
 John 4:42 What do we know? That this is indeed the savior of the world
 John 4:42 Who is this (indeed)? The Savior of the world
 John 4:43 When did he depart for Galilee? After (the) two days
 John 4:43 For where did he depart? Galilee
 John 4:44 Who had testified that a prophet has no honor in his own hometown? Jesus himself
 John 4:44 What had Jesus testified? That a prophet has no honor in his own hometown
 John 4:44 Where does a prophet have no honor? In his own hometown
 John 4:44 Who has no honor in his own hometown? A prophet
 John 4:45 Where did he come? (to) Galilee
 John 4:45 When did the Galileans welcome him? When he came to Galilee
 John 4:45 Who welcomed him? Galileans
 John 4:45 Where had they (too) gone? To the feast
 John 4:46 Where did he come again? To Cana in Galilee
 John 4:46 What had he made wine? The water
 John 4:46 Where was an official whose son was ill? Capernaum
 John 4:46 What was there (at Capernaum)? An official whose son was ill
 John 4:47 When did he go to him? When this man heard that Jesus had come (from Judea to Galilee)
 John 4:47 Who heard that Jesus had come from Judea to Galilee? This man
 John 4:47 From where had Jesus come? Judea (to Galilee)
 John 4:47 Who was at the point of death? His son (he)
 John 4:47 What did this man hear? (that) Jesus had come from Judea to Galilee

 John 4:50 What will your son do? Live
 John 4:50 What did Jesus say to him? "Go; your son will live."
 John 4:50 Who believed the word that Jesus spoke to him? The man
 John 4:50 What did the man believe? The word that Jesus spoke to him (and went on his way)
 John 4:51 Who met him? His servants
 John 4:51 When did his servants meet him? As he was going down
 John 4:51 Where was he going? Down
 John 4:51 Who was recovering? His son
 John 4:52 What did he ask them? The hour when he began to get better
 John 4:52 What did they say to him? "Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him."
 John 4:52 When did the fever leave him? Yesterday at the seventh hour
 John 4:52 What left him? The fever

John 4:53 What had Jesus said to him? "Your son will live"

John 4:53 Who knew that was the hour when Jesus had said to him, "Your son will live"? The Father

John 4:53 Who believed? He himself, and all his household

John 4:54 What was this now? The second sign

John 4:54 Who had come from Judea to Galilee? Jesus (he)

John 4:54 From where had Jesus come? Judea (to Galilee)
