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15 Days of Prayer for Hope and Harvest: March 1, 2026 – March 15, 2026

Day of Hope March 15, 2026

We all need hope. Everyone we know also needs hope. And we realize we need a harvest. Almost everyone is aware of what a harvest is. It is a time of gathering the crops that have matured enough to be ready to eat or sell. Spiritually, a harvest is a time of gathering the souls that God has brought to Himself. It is a time of joining God in making disciples. As God brings hope and revival to the hearts of His children, we will be in the correct mindset to join Him in the harvest. Our nation, our state, our church, you, and I are all in need of a Holy Spirit revival. God is leading us into **15 Days of Prayer for Hope and Harvest** leading up to our **Day of Hope, March 15, 2026**. Our primary focus needs to be on experiencing true revival and renewal personally, and joining God in making disciples of those around us. This prayer guide is provided to help you prepare for both. Our first day of this prayer guide begins Sunday, March 1, 2026 and continues through Sunday, March 15, 2026, our **Day of Hope**.

Each day is broken into three sections:

Section 1: A devotional written for believers

Section 2: Scripture verses that support the devotional*

Section 3: A short prayer to help begin your prayer time each day

*All Scripture is from the New International Version.

There are several major focuses we need to pray for every day:

1. Pray for a Holy Spirit-led worldwide revival and harvest.
2. Pray for our nation to experience Hope through a revival and a harvest.
3. Pray for our state to experience Hope through revival and a harvest.
4. Pray for our church to experience Hope through revival and a harvest.
 - a. Pray for our pastor, **Bro. Tim McGehee** and his family, and our church leadership.
 - b. Pray for our evangelist **André Dugger** and his ministry, **From The Depths Ministries**, as he prepares to lead our special Day of Hope.
5. Pray for your family to experience Hope through revival and a harvest.

6. Pray for you to experience Hope through revival and a harvest.
- a. Ask God to break you.
 - b. Ask God to reveal to you any unconfessed sin in your life and then repent of that sin.
 - c. Ask God to give you a love for His Word and a desire to spend time daily studying it and meditating on it.
 - d. Ask God to use you to be a blessing to the world by using you to share His good news both here at home and around the world.
 - e. Ask God to speak to you concerning His desire for you, your family, and our church family.

As we spend time each day in prayer for people in each of these areas of our lives, and as we spend time in God's Word, we will be in a position to see God bring hope to our hearts. This hope will come as revival to us and as a harvest around us. Commit to spending these 15 days with a renewed focus on God and His Word, and we may see Him bless us with both a personal and church revival that will forever change us and our church. Pray that God will lead us to a renewed desire within us to join Him in the harvest as we share the hope of Jesus with others. Be sensitive to the Holy Spirit as He speaks to you during this special time of prayer.

Day 1
March 1, 2026

Distractions are all around you, but so is God. Focus on God rather than the distractions. To do this, God must be the One who is most important to you, and you must be engulfed in being in His presence. When you are reading your favorite book, section of the newspaper, or online social media site, you drown out everything else around you—including people who are special to you. You hardly notice the other activities going on because you are doing something you enjoy. God wants you to so enjoy being with Him that everything else fades away and it is just you and Him. Sometimes you may need to go to a quiet place to help remove distractions; however, God's desire is that you become so in love with Him, and so focused on Him, that even in the midst of distractions, your attention is solely on Him. Determine to focus on God today.

I long to dwell in your tent forever and take refuge in the shelter of your wings.

Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already been made perfect, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me. Brothers, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.

I come before You today with a desire to focus on You. I realize there will be many things that attempt to take my attention off of You. I want to be passionate for You. Forgive me when I am more passionate for other things than I am for You.

Day 2
March 2, 2026

Just as a soldier has certain equipment to wear into combat, God has provided you with special spiritual equipment for your battle as well. No soldier wants to be caught unprepared for an attack, and if you put on God's full armor, you will be prepared. God wants you to wear truth around you even though you live in a world of lies. Let righteousness cover you in the midst of an unrighteous society. Live with God's peace that allows you to stand strong in the chaos surrounding you. Let your faith in God be your shield of protection. Live with the assurance of God's salvation and use His Word as your sword to fight the enemy. As you travel through this world, use the greatest tool and weapon God has provided you—prayer. Pray always, remaining in constant communication with God, your Commander in Chief.

Ephesians 6:13-18

Therefore, put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints.

Day 3
March 3, 2026

On a hot dry day, few things, if any, satisfy your thirst like fresh, cold water. Whether it is a deer running through the fields on a hot summer day or you running through life and experiencing struggles and difficulties, nothing can quench thirst like good, pure water. God uses the fresh, cool water of springs to comfort you and animals physically, and He uses the fresh, cool water of His Spirit to refresh you and bless you spiritually. Many people understand the importance of physical refreshment, but few really understand the need for spiritual refreshment. God created you as a spiritual being who needs His spiritual refreshment each moment of every day. Choose daily to drink of God and His Word and be refreshed by His Holy Spirit!

John 4:14

But whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life.

John 7:38-39 *Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, streams of living water will flow from within him. By this he meant the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were later to receive. Up to that time the Spirit had not been given, since Jesus had not yet been glorified.*

Day 13
March 13, 2026

You live in a time when there are many types of communication available; and most of these are instant in nature. Years ago, people had very few options for communicating with someone who was not with them physically. The limited options were anything but instant in nature. One thing that has never changed, however, is the opportunity for you to communicate with God at any time and any place. God is always available for you because He is living in you. Communication with God is instantaneous for those who choose to participate through listening, talking, meditating, journaling, or writing letters to Him. God loves spending time with you. God's desire is for you to have a similar passion for spending time with Him. You never have to worry about waking God because He never sleeps. You never have to worry about bothering God because His children are never a bother to Him. God is always available, and He eagerly awaits your calling.

March 14, 2026

God already knows you completely, but the more time you spend with Him, the better you come to know Him. God wants you to have a passion for Him. He wants you to desire to know Him better today than you did yesterday. He wants you to love and seek Him with all of your heart, soul, mind, and strength. You could add up all your achievements and all your credentials and they would amount to absolutely nothing compared to knowing and loving God. Today God's assignment for you is simple: Love Him. As you spend time together with God today, loving each other, you will find the fulfillment and joy for which you have been longing.

Mark 12:30

Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.

Day 15
March 15, 2026

What are you running after? Look around and notice what most people seem to be running toward. You will soon discover that most are desperately seeking things such as money, possessions, and the basic necessities of life. As God's child, you should be different. God promises to take care of you and provide for you the things you need, but He has a requirement of you. His requirement is for you to seek Him and His righteousness first and foremost. Run after God. As you make God your focus and desire, He promises to take care of the basic necessities of life for which many spend their lives striving. The difference between others and you is that they are seeking the temporal things of life and you are seeking God and His eternal things. Those who seek the temporal things temporarily get what they can provide for themselves, but you get all that God can provide for all eternity.

Matthew 6:28-33

And why do you worry about clothes? See how the lilies of the field grow. They do not labor or spin. Yet I tell you that not even Solomon in all his splendor was dressed like one of these. If that is how God clothes the grass of the field, which is here today and tomorrow is thrown into the fire, will he not much more clothe you, O you of little faith? So do not worry, saying, "What shall we eat?" or "What shall we drink?" or "What shall we wear?" For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

2 Corinthians 4:18 *So, we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.*

Dear God,

I confess that sometimes I run after the same things the world runs after rather than running after You. Please forgive me for this sin. I commit to You today to run after You and Your righteousness. Please use me as an instrument of revival in the life of my family and our church family.
