Call To Worship 1 Peter 1: 3-7 (ESV)

3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! 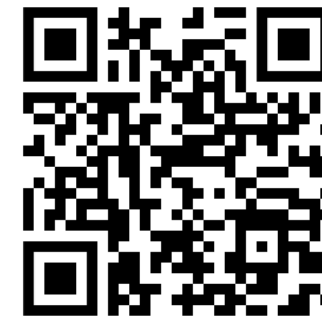
