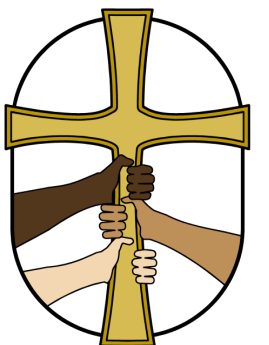

## Wiggle ROOM
