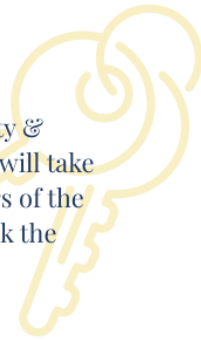

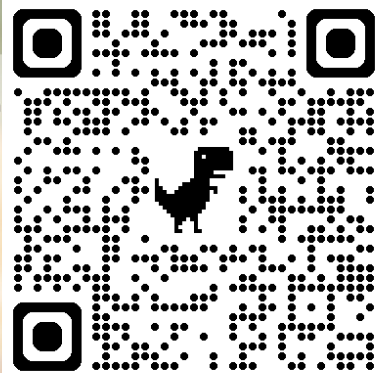
FIRM FOUNDATION TUTORING PROGRAM

BECOME A TUTOR THIS FALL

Fall Tutoring begins September 2 and goes through early December (with a training session the week of August 25)

Firm Foundation Tutoring, a ministry of New City Fellowship, is looking for at least 20 new volunteer tutors this fall. Because we have a 1:1 ratio for tutors and kids, your involvement helps welcome a kid from our community! Tutors choose the location (1142 Hodiamont Ave OR 3502 Grace Ave) and time (Monday-Thursday options starting between 4-5:30 p.m.) and typically work with the same student all semester.

Tutors will receive training and support to equip them in their role (no prior experience needed). Substitute tutors are also needed, if you are not able to make a semester-long commitment.
