Medical Mission trip to Mexico

In late March, Trey was able to take a team from Dallas Bay Church to Yucatan, Mexico for a medical mission trip. The trip was successful in so many ways! We were able to truly help many people with their physical needs. That opened the door for us to talk about their spiritual needs, and many people made decisions for Christ. We also made some great connections that will help our missionaries, the Montejo family, in their long-term ministry there in the Yucatan region.

Men's Conference in Cuba

In May, Trey went with a small team to Cuba to serve with our Daystar missionaries, the Cordovi family. Our team was able to partner with Nazareth Baptist in Havana to host a special men's conference. Even during some difficult days in Cuba, we had over 50 men come out to learn more about discipleship. Our team was also able to do some home visits and share the love of Christ with multiple families. All of the homes happily received the free groceries that we were giving away, and many also received the free gift of eternal life. It is always such a joy to be able to share the Good News and pray with someone as they receive Christ into their life!

As a prayer request, would you continue to pray for the Cordovi family in Cuba? For several months now, the people of Cuba have been dealing with severe power outages (sometimes 8-9 days at a time), no fuel, no running water, and extremely hard circumstances. Through it all, the Cordovis have been serving the Lord and trying to battle through the hardships that come along with daily life.

Middle School Mania in Orlando

In June, Trey hosted a team of 130+ middle school students on a mission trip to Orlando. The team from Johnson Ferry Baptist partnered with several church plants all around the city of Orlando. It was an incredible week of seeing the Lord work in big ways! One of the stories that I loved came from Redemption Orlando Church (pictured above). We helped them run a VBS in this church that is over 100 years old and is now a revitalization project. Even though their VBS only had around 12 to 15 kids in attendance each day, they celebrated as if they had won the Super Bowl! The pastor told me that he had sent some videos to a shut-in who helped with the youth program many years ago. They were overjoyed to see kids back in the church, as it has been a long time since they have seen more than 2-3 kids show up for anything at the church. Our team helped energize them to continue taking steps to reach their neighborhood with the Gospel, and it was all done by middle school students!



Ecuador Mission trip

In June, Trey served with a team that did some very hard work for the Lyon family in Ecuador. The Lyons do ministry in the mountains of northern Ecuador with the indigenous Kichwa people. A big part of their ministry is training and discipling the Believers there, and they often host people at their home. Our team was able to help create some meeting spaces on their property that will be wonderful places to host discipleship sessions and small group events. We definitely worked hard, but it was a blessing to see the finished work at the end of the trip. We know these spaces will help produce much long-term fruit. VBS in South Africa

In April, Trey led a team from Seattle to serve with our missionaries in Cape Town, South Africa. This was the third year in a row for Cedar Park Christian to run the VBS at the church plant in Fisantekraal, and it is so great to see the growth of the church and of the kids that we have been ministering to. A big blessing has been watching the teens from the church step up and help lead. This year they really jumped in and helped to run a lot of the program with us. With nearly 300 kids attending each day, it was an action-packed week to say the least! It's wonderful knowing that there is much long-term fruit that remains even after the team goes home. The LeRoux family is doing a wonderful job of leading this sweet congregation closer to the Lord.
