Let the Bubble Settle

A memory that has stayed with me for all of my life was one with my "Pap" in his garage workshop. He had an old vice and level attached to his workbench. I used to watch him tinker with regripping old golf clubs and such. I remember watching him set the level on the club, crouch down, and wait for the tiny bubble inside the glass to settle. Only when that bubble rested perfectly between the lines would he begin to apply the new grip.

What still fascinates me is how much trust he placed in that little tool. If the bubble said the club was straight, he believed it. If it said the club was off, he didn't argue. He didn't try to "eyeball it," didn't rely on his instincts, didn't assume he knew better. The level told the truth, and he aligned his work to it.

Galatians 2:15-21 reminds us that the gospel functions much the same way. Paul explains that no amount of effort, rule-keeping, or moral "eyeballing" can make us right with God. "We know that a person is not justified by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ." Like the level on my Pap's vice, Christ alone reveals what is truly straight and righteous. And when we try to build our lives on our own measurements, things inevitably tilt.

Paul goes even further: "I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me." The life we now live isn't propped up by our performance but anchored in His perfection. Our standing with God doesn't wobble when we fail, because it never rested on us to begin with. Christ is the level that never shifts, never cracks, never lies.

Yet how often do our hearts drift back toward self-reliance? We measure ourselves by productivity, by how well we handled a situation, by how "spiritual" we feel on a given day. We forget that the only true measurement of our righteousness is Christ Himself and His finished work, His perfect obedience, His death and resurrection applied to us by grace.

My Pap trusted that vice and level because it had proven itself over decades of use. Christ has proven Himself over eternity. His righteousness is steady. His grace is exact. His justification is complete.

Maybe today, as we build, plan, parent, serve, or simply try to make sense of the world, we can pause long enough to let the bubble settle. To align our hearts not with our own attempts at

goodness but with the unchanging truth of the gospel.

Let's step into this day with quiet confidence not in our ability to measure up, but in Christ's perfect work that has already made us right with God.
