

Dear praying friends and family—



Already two years here—I can't believe it. There IS significant fruit and that is encouraging. At the same time – it is quite *different* actually. Church planting in America or RESTARTING that is, versus starting a church from scratch, even if it's in a foreign country – yes, it's QUITE different. I think, ***we have uncovered a STRONGHOLD area*** for the enemy – with churches *up here* closing – it seems left and right!! We have attempted to do some of the same things that were **successful** in Ukraine/Russia. Here: *different* for sure. I would always tell the Russians/Ukrainians that I had been there long enough that I was “half Russian.” Perhaps I so adjusted to that style of ministry and expecting a certain thing from folks... WHAT AM I TRYING TO SAY? Basically, that things are different/difficult here. At the same time... PEOPLE ARE PEOPLE and they *basically* have the SAME problems everywhere you go. GOD'S WORD is the **same solution** as well. Believed/applied – the GOSPEL never fails!! *Amen to that.*

We drove to North Carolina during the holidays to visit with our family. It was PRECIOUS times. **I miss my kids.** I can only imagine the joy and privilege it would be to be able to go to church with them each week, sing specials regularly, **serve the Lord alongside**, shoulder to shoulder. We had that privilege when they were kids. I may have taken it for granted that it would last forever. *Deep down*, knowing that, of course, it would not. The boys, Marc/Joshua/Caleb, have their own families –they are building their own Hess-tribe. We're proud of them in so many ways. Anna – she is so grown up now. Quite a responsible adult – 24 as of this letter. I am quite honestly, too young to have a daughter that “old” – LOL.

We have traveled the country preaching “redeem the time” with my ruler / yardstick and a few of our favorite illustrations... God used those lessons in my life and I think in a few others—wow! I probably feel as motivated today as any time in my life to truly redeem the time. I'm only 55, but we see and feel a difference in our health. So I know I simply DON'T have forever to do what God has called and enabled me to do.

We had three professions of faith this past year – they were Kaitlyn, April, and Dylan. Please pray for these three: they all need baptized.... I am perhaps more RUSSIAN in that regard than the average “ameri-kański pastor” – in that if someone makes



May the Lord Jesus lead us PLEASE! 2) One of the two families that WE {Brother John Bailes, YOU ALL and I} specifically have asked God for HELP here in the ministry. They joined in November. Glory! 3) As well, A young man in the church asked me to be his accountability partner this year as we study through the Commands of Christ. I WAS THRILLED! That is another answer to prayer! **We NEED more FAITHFUL, dependable young men at this work here!** 4) So, on Tuesdays, we are doing a “Training Faithful Men's Class” and it is bearing fruit. So we HAVE MUCH to thank our Lord for!
