The following day, I met up with a language school classmate for breakfast. After catching up with her and talking about future plans, there was a long pause in the conversation. Then she began, "So, you're a Christian, right? How did you come to make that decision?" What an open door from the Lord! I happily shared my testimony with her, and then also some online resources that would help her understand more about who Jesus is, who the God of the Bible is, and what it means to be a Christian. Over the weekend, I traveled with some Spanish friends (some of whom I had met through Brilla conversation classes) to San Sebastian in the north of Spain. We all have a mutual friend who now serves the Lord in that area (but before had been in Alcala serving at the cafe). On Sunday, these ladies all wanted to go to Lauren's church, knowing that it was an important part of why she moved to that area of Spain. None of them had ever been to an evangelical church service. It was a privilege to be a part of their conversation in the car ride home from the trip,
